It may be noted that hereafter, no further pre-applicant queries/clarifications in respect of RFQ will be entertained.





Do you mean "projects" would be like the one for which the RFQ is being submitted i.e. port project on a 30 year concession on PPP basis with a Port Authority or something else? Does it include logistics parks, warehousing, trucking, CFS, ICD, Rail etc? Does it include projects in other sectors like Power, Telecom, IT etc as experience for these projects can also be counted towards Technical Qualification?	Please refer Clause no 3.2.1 (i) & (ii)
