In a port-related environment, tons of dangerous goods are traded, handled and stored every day.

Dangerous goods can be a risk to health, safety, property and environment. Following international and national legislation, stakeholders are obligated to handle these goods in the safest possible way.

It goes without saying that complying to safety regulations has added value for the entire port community and undoubtedly pays in the long run.

FOR WHOM

WHAT
